

Make your Own M4C Badge!

Wear it every day up until the weekend in April. Adults you can do this too!

REQUIREMENTS

Paper or card - this could be white, red or yellow

Coloured pens - red, yellow, black

Pritt stick, glue or cellotape

a large safety pin, or elastic (enough to go around your head) or a piece of string
optional - cardboard

INSTRUCTIONS:

You can print out, the badge itself in colour, or simply use the outline below.

Colour. (if using paper, draw the outline letters M4C'11) Add some music notes to personalise your badge. I did mine in yellow and stuck in on to the red paper with Pritt stick.

Optional -If you have a laminator you could make it waterproof, or you could stick cellotape neatly across, in strips or you could paint it with PVC glue and leave it to dry (at least an hour, I'd guess)

NB. If you've used paper, you might want to double the thickness - be sure to stick layers securely with Pritt stick

Cut out. If you've used paper, consider using cardboard at the back to make it stronger.

Using cellotape, attach the safety pin to the back of your badge - be careful not to stick yourself.

Alternatively, cellotape the ends of a piece of string, and you can tie it on to you bag or hang it from your parents' car mirror, or on your bedroom door handle . . .
